Pekin Hospital Foundation, and Park Court Limited (includes real estate services for PHS).

Pekin Hospital has a service area of approximately 75,000. The hospital is composed of 125 licensed beds - 98 acute care with a 27-bed skilled nursing unit, and a home health care program with a total of 840 employees. There are 74 physicians on active staff, along with 200+ physicians on consulting staff. Net revenues are \$87 million

Pekin Hospital offers a full range of clinical and diagnostic services including MRI, cardiac catheter lab and 64 slice CT. The hospital benefits from a clinical affiliation for tertiary services with the 548-bed OSF Saint Francis Medical Center in nearby Peoria.

Pekin Hospital ranked in the top 10% of hospitals nationally in Physician, Patient and Employee Satisfaction, according to Press Ganey. Additionally, the hospital was a recipient of the Lincoln Foundation (Baldrige) Silver Award for excellence in the pursuit of quality and the Paragon Award for Clinical Excellence.
