The Missouri Hospital Association is seeking two qualified individuals to lead its statewide quality improvement activities — one to oversee and direct a two-year federal contract and other voluntary improvement hospital initiatives and the other to provide day-to-day project management. Both positions require a baccalaureate degree in an applicable discipline with a graduate degree in public health or health administration preferred. Clinical training and experience is preferred. At least one position requires a minimum of a baccalaureate degree in nursing. Preference will be given to those who have experience implementing collaboratives on a regional or statewide basis. Experience in grant management and statistical analyses of performance metrics is a definite plus.
