FCH has over 50 physicians on staff. Located in Marathon, Florida, FCH offers health care services for children, adolescents, adults, and geriatric patients. FCH has various educational affiliations and serves as a training site for nursing, technicians, and other clinical professionals

The hospital services the town of Marathon (population 9,000) and Monroe County (population 73000) with net revenues of \$30M and an ADC of 6.5. They have recently installed HMS software and have renovations scheduled to include remodeling the digital mammography area.

Clinical services include: emergency department, acute inpatient medical/surgical services, minimal pediatric services, intensive and coronary care services, telemetry, respiratory care services, diagnostic imaging services, laboratory and pathology services, rehabilitation services (PT, OT), resource management services, outpatient and inpatient surgical services, pharmacy services, nutritional services, and others.
